Whereas, The airport property is covered by certain obligations and assurances to the Federal Government for the purposes of an airport, and
Whereas, Assurance number twenty-eight, requires the airport sponsor to furnish land for use in connection with any air traffic control or air navigation activities, or weather reporting and communication activities related thereto, or any areas of land or water, or estate therein as the Secretary considers necessary or desirable for construction, operation and maintenance at Federal expense of space or facilities for such purposes, and
Whereas, The current agreement expires September 30, 2025, and the Federal Government has a continuing need to occupy, and
