Chairman Nabywaniec called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and offered Privilege of the Floor, however no one present wished to speak. The Committee approved the minutes of the February meeting.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Designating Jefferson County as Lead Agency Under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and Determining a Type II Action for the Deferiet Paper Mill Demolition Project and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Potter, seconded by Legislator Ferris, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Green 2 Green Consulting LLC in Relation to Community Air Monitoring Services Associated with the Abbass Foods Buildings 2 & 3 Demolition Project and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Ferris, seconded by Legislator Grant, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Authorizing an Agreement with 12625 Morris Tract Road for a Temporary Easement of Certain Owned and Obligated Property and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Reed, seconded by Legislator Potter, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Authorizing Inter-Municipal Agreements for Shared Services with The Jefferson County Stormwater Coalition Members and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Potter, seconded by Legislator Grant, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Volunteer Transportation Center for First Mile, Last Mile Services and Amending the 2026 County Budget in Relation Thereto and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Potter, seconded by Legislator Ferris, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Authorizing Supplemental Agreement #1 with the New York State Department of Transportation for the 2024-2025 Federal Transit Administration Section 5311 Rural Transportation Program and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Potter, seconded by Legislator Boulio, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Amending the 2026 County Budget in Relation to the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee's Stop-DWI High Visibility Enforcement Grant and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator McBride, seconded by Legislator Boulio, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Amending the 2026 County Budget to Recognize Insurance Recovery Funds and Allocating the Same in Sheriff's Office Budget and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Ferris, seconded by Legislator Potter, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

Chairman Nabywaniec introduced a resolution Reappropriating Funds from Various Unspent Homeland Security Grants Relative to the Sheriff's Office and Amending the 2026 County Budget in Relation Thereto and entertained a motion for consideration. A motion was duly made by Legislator Ferris, seconded by Legislator Grant, and there being no discussion, the Committee agreed to sponsor the resolution as presented.

There being no further business of the Committee, on a motion by Legislator Potter, seconded by Legislator Ferris, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
