

Resolution 25-16

Adapting the Supportive Service Policy

Whereas, Technical Advisory 26-02 requires local Workforce Development Boards to develop compliant policy to address the provision of supportive services which includes needs-related payments and other allowable participant support expenses; and

Whereas, a local policy has been developed. In accordance with the Technical Advisory, participants will be referred to other organizations. As a last resort after all other available funding sources are exhausted, and the services are deemed necessary for the individual to participate in WIOA training activities will supportive services be offered. All supportive services must remain within the Individual Training Account Caps; and

Whereas, all services will be subject to funding availability.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development Board adapts the Support Services policy commencing with Program Year 2026 funding.
