- Does your household qualify for TANF or have income of less than 200% of the federal poverty level?



ON THE JOB TRAINING

The OJT program is designed to help unemployed and underemployed people improve their situation in the workforce, while giving businesses a financial incentive to hire and train them in full-time skilled or semi-skilled occupations.

The WorkPlace will reimburse your business for up to 50% of the base wages while the worker is in the training phase.

TIPS FOR ATTENDING A JOB FAIR


- Practice a 30 second commercial. Work on developing a short sales pitch that highlights your skills and experience.


